



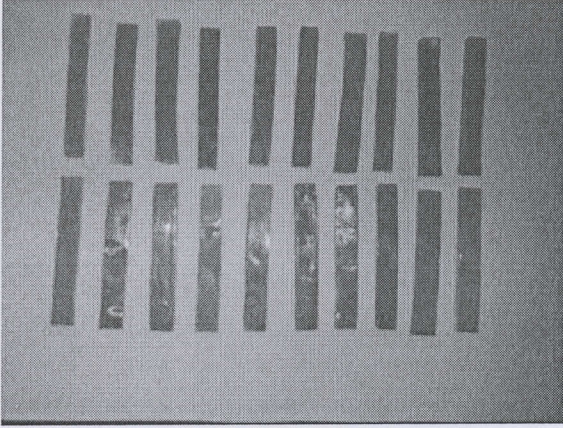


Fig 1: Silver nano samples (meliodent eco)

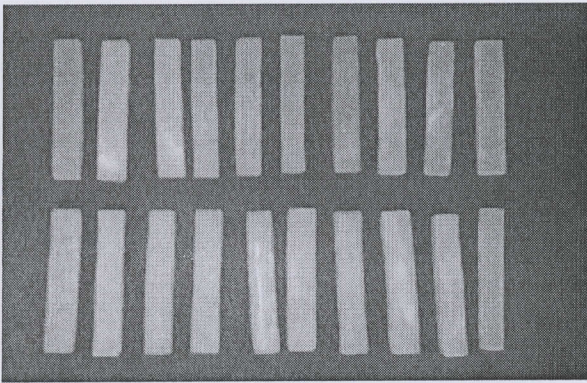


Fig 2: Control group samples (meliodent eco)

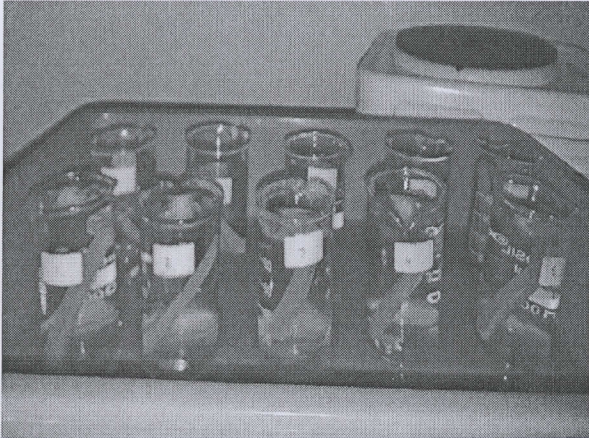


Fig 3: Samples placed in 100ml beakers and labeled

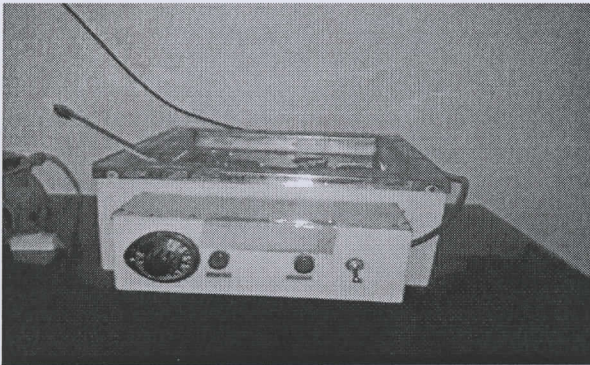


Fig 4: Water bath with thermometer to maintain temperature

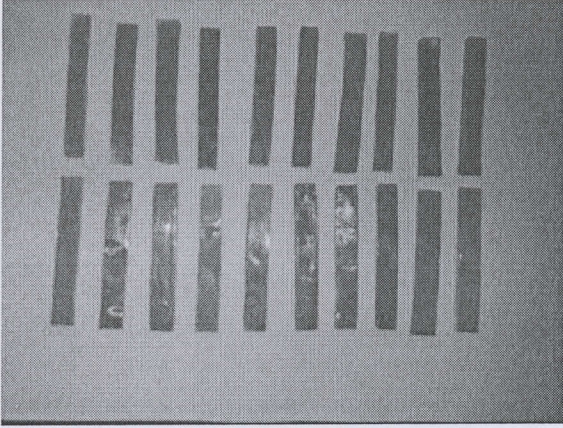


Fig 1: Silver nano samples (meliodent eco)

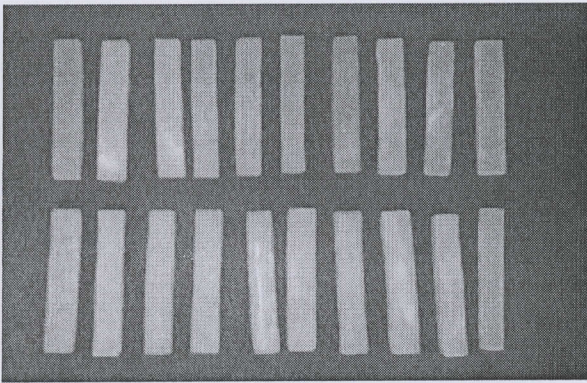


Fig 2: Control group samples (meliodent eco)

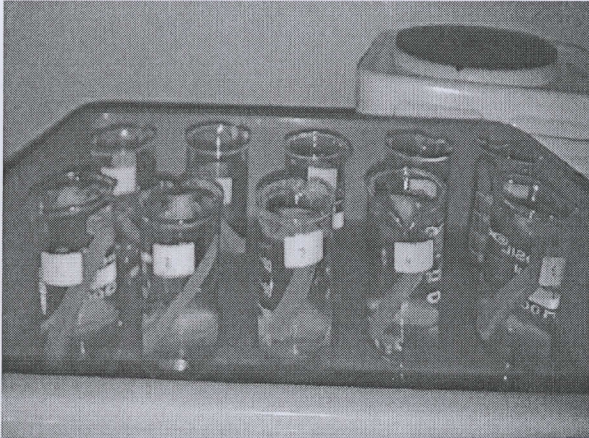


Fig 3: Samples placed in 100ml beakers and labeled

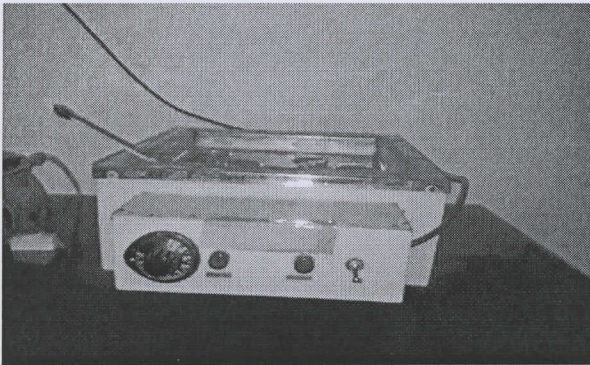


Fig 4: Water bath with thermometer to maintain temperature

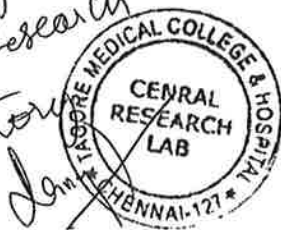



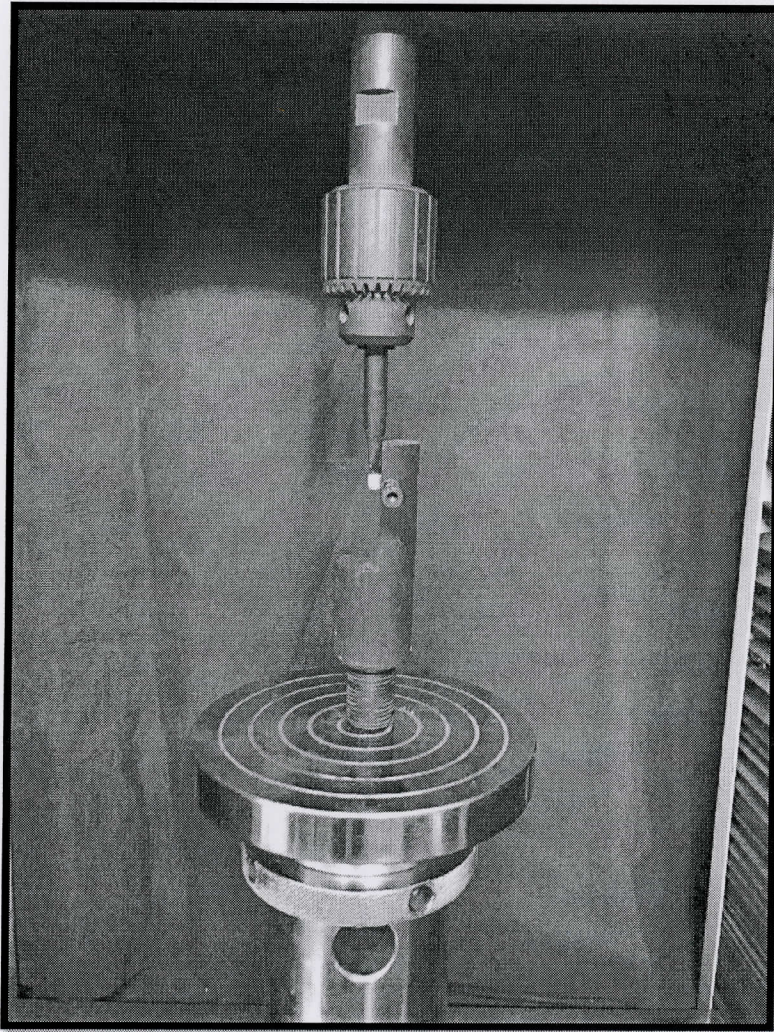


Fig 1. To test shear bond between metal ceramic using universal testing machine.

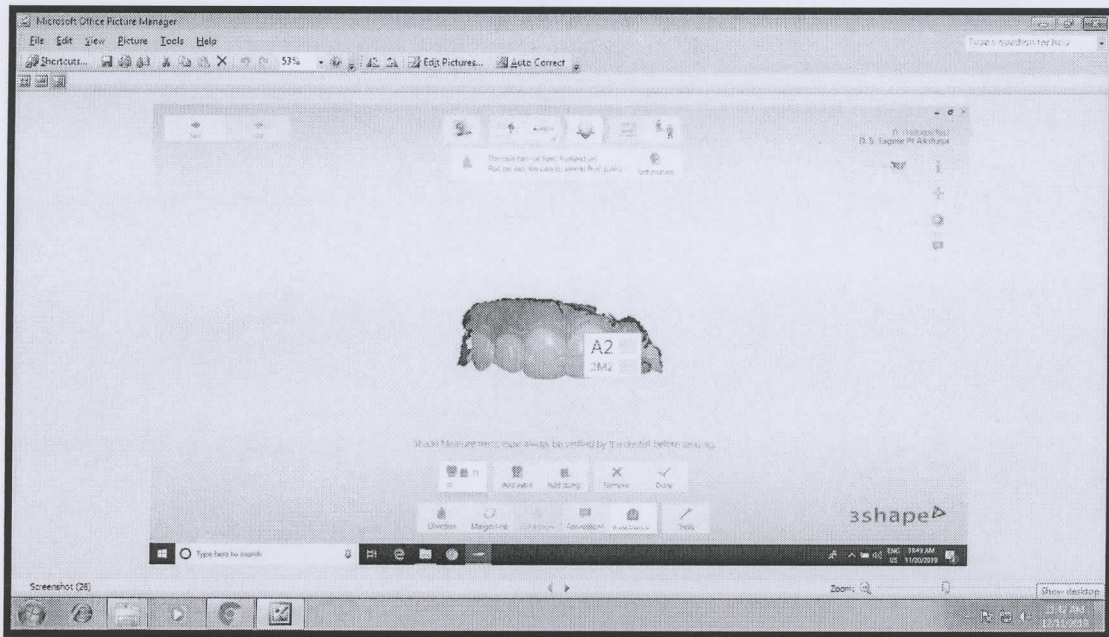


Fig: 1 Tooth shade selection with intraoral scanner using TRIOS Scanner

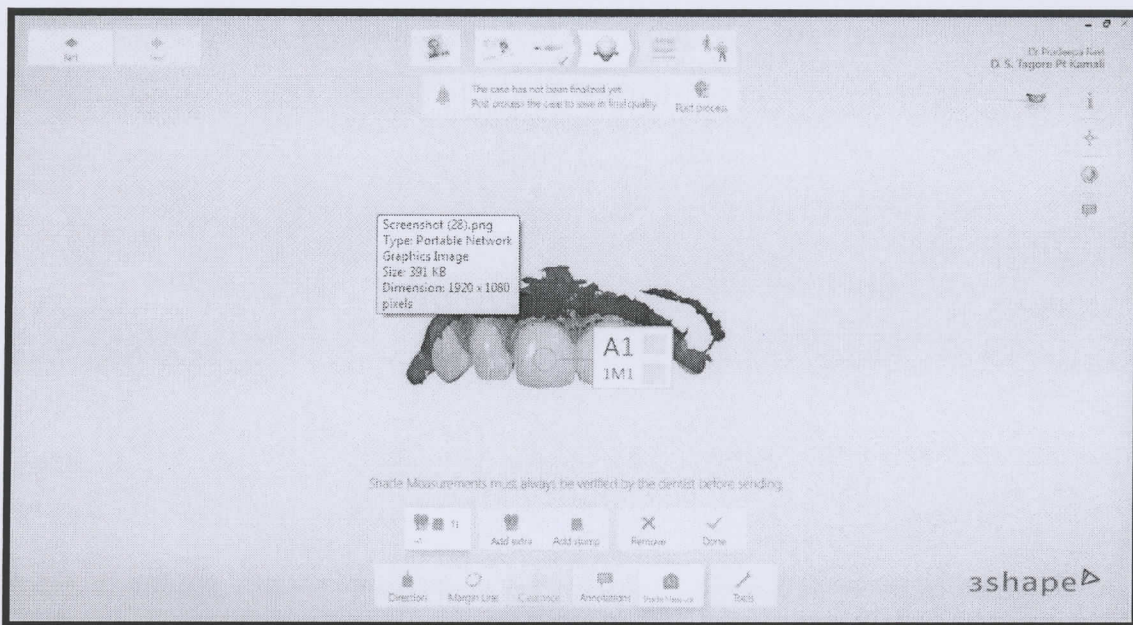


Fig: 2 Tooth shade selection with intraoral scanner using TRIOS Scanner

March 4th to 11th 2018

Journey began on March 4th by Malaysian airlines and reached KL in the evening. We reached the university campus by a van and were received by Mr. Izat, Programme coordinator and Dr Jacob John near the college accommodation allotted to us.

Programme started on 5th morning, an official photograph of the entire team was taken by Mr Izat. The students were issued log books to enter the cases they observe or assist. Students were split into two groups based on their interests, each comprising of seven students. One group was sent to the Department of Restorative Dentistry and the other to the Department of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery. The travel to Malaysia and within Malaysia was simply at its best, thanks to our staff for such a wonderful arrangement.

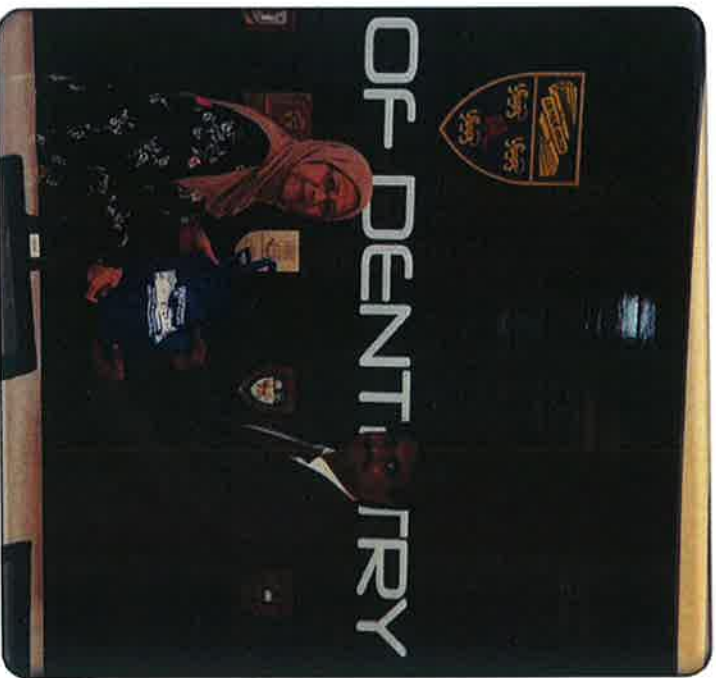
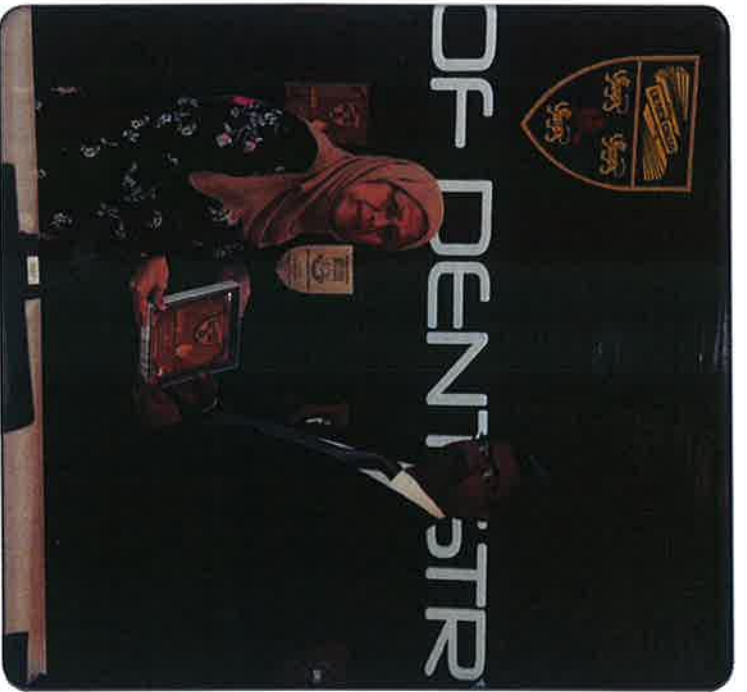

She was taught about the various acupressure points. Acupressure points were studied to evaluate the association of pain on rubber dam application. The study was later accepted by ICMR.
