Intellectual property rights and patent program was organized by Tagore Dental College and Hospital on 02-12-2020 at 10:00 in the auditorium. Dr. I. Kannan was invited as the resource speaker.

Dr. I. Kannan, is associate professor of Microbiology, Tagore medical college and hospital. He has completed his degree in medical microbiology from the doctoral University of Madras. He holds the post of officer incharge of the central research laboratory. Further he is the technical manager in the molecular virology laboratory of Tagore medical college and hospital which is NABL accredited. With more than 25 years of teaching experience and with more than 100 research publications, he has also authored a textbook on immunology for MJP publishers and a book on microbiology for Elsevier. He has also submitted seven unique DNA sequences in GEN bank, NCBI, USA.

Dr. S. Balagopal, Professor and Head, Vice principal addressed and introduced the topic of the program to the audience. Dr. Chitraa R. Chandran, Principal welcomed the speaker and address the gathering. Principal encouraged the staffs and students to work towards getting patency of their individual ideas. Dr. Geetha Priya (Reader, Dept of Conservative Dentistry and Endodontics) introduced the speaker of the day for the lecture and invited him to the podium.

The lecture presentation focused on patency and intellectual property rights which was focused on the concepts patenting and the ways in which one can safeguard, his/her work from being stolen. This program also gave a through insight on the steps to be taken right after any major breakthrough achieved and to prevent stealth of intellectual property by others. It was also beneficial in telling the difference between levels of patent which can be imposed on the work.
