IMMUNIZATION POLICY

Immunization policy is to prevent or reduce the risk of transmission of vaccine-preventable and other communicable diseases between faculty, student-dentists and residents and their patients and other persons at Tagore Dental College.

Immunizations substantially reduce the number of staff and students susceptible to infectious diseases, as well as the potential for disease transmission to other staff and patients. Therefore, immunizations are an essential part of infection prevention and control programs.

This policy shall apply to all clinical staff (for example: dental hygienists, dental assistants, and radiology technicians), clinical faculty, student-dentists and residents.

All staffs and students enrolled or joined in the college are compulsorily immunized for Hepatitis B as Hepatitis B is a potentially life-threatening liver infection which spreads by exposure to infected bodily fluids and front-line workers and doctors are more exposed to it and booster dose is given to persons in the interval of 0days, 1month and 6months. Students are vaccinated in the first year itself.
