



PROGRAM REPORT

World health organization celebrates 14th June every year as “World Blood Donor Day”. The aim of this celebration is to raise awareness on blood and its products transfusion at global level. It also provides an opportunity to awaken the government and other health agencies to provide adequate awareness and infrastructure to increase the collection of blood from voluntary and healthy donors. Safe collection and transfusion of blood and its products is a crucial aspect of care and public health.

To ensure that everyone who needs safe blood has access to it, all countries need voluntary, unpaid donors who give blood regularly. Throughout the COVID-19 pandemic, despite limited mobility and other challenges, blood donors in many countries have continued to donate blood and plasma to patients who need transfusion. This extraordinary effort during a time of unprecedented crisis highlights the crucial role of well-organized, committed voluntary, non-remunerated blood donors in ensuring a safe and sufficient blood supply during normal and emergency times.

Focus of this year's campaign

For 2022, the World Blood Donor Day slogan will be “Donating blood is an act of solidarity. Join the effort and save lives”. According to the WHO, the theme will put light on the roles that voluntary blood donation plays in saving lives every year across the globe. The specific objectives of this year's campaign are to:

- Thank blood donors in the world and create wider public awareness of the need for regular, unpaid blood donation;
- Highlight the need for committed, year-round blood donation, to maintain adequate supplies and achieve universal and timely access to safe blood transfusion;
- Recognize and promote the values of voluntary unpaid blood donation in enhancing community solidarity and social cohesion

In light of this focus, NSS unit of Tagore dental college and Hospital conducted a lively talk on "Donate blood, Join the efforts and save a life".

PROGRAM DETAILS

A live Lecture was arranged by the NSS unit of Tagore Dental College on '**DONATE BLOOD, JOIN THE EFFORT& SAVE A LIFE**' at APJ Abdul kalam auditorium, Tagore Dental College and Hospital. Around 83 participants including faculties and students participated. The show was hosted by Dr Vaishnavi, Chairman, NSS Unit and was inaugurated by Dr. Sai Krishna, Head and Professor, Dept of Oral and Maxillofacial Pathology, Tagore Dental College and Hospital.

He spoke about the importance of blood donation and activities carried forward by the NSS unit over the past years. He emphasised that safe blood donation is a critical aspect of Public Health and patient.

The star of the show was Prof Dr. C.P.Luck MD, Pathology Head and professor, Dept of Pathology, Tagore Medical College and hospital; she had obtained both her degrees from Kilpauk Medical College. She is also proficient in analysing blood mismatching, typing and various histopathologies.

The show started with the dynamic talk by Dr Luck who spoke on the tagline "**DONATE BLOOD, JOIN THE EFFORT& SAVE A LIFE**". She explained the meaning of this theme and made elaborate explanations for frequently asked questions regarding blood donation. Around 100 participants had attended the program.

She paved a way to break the doubts which have been lingering in the minds of many with respect to the safety aspect of blood donation for the self and others. She also highlighted about the blood grouping and importance of donating blood.

The lively session had a spirited Q and A session at the end where the participants clarified their doubt. This program ended with a vote of thanks by Dr. Vaishnavi, Chairman, NSS Unit, Tagore Dental College and Hospital.

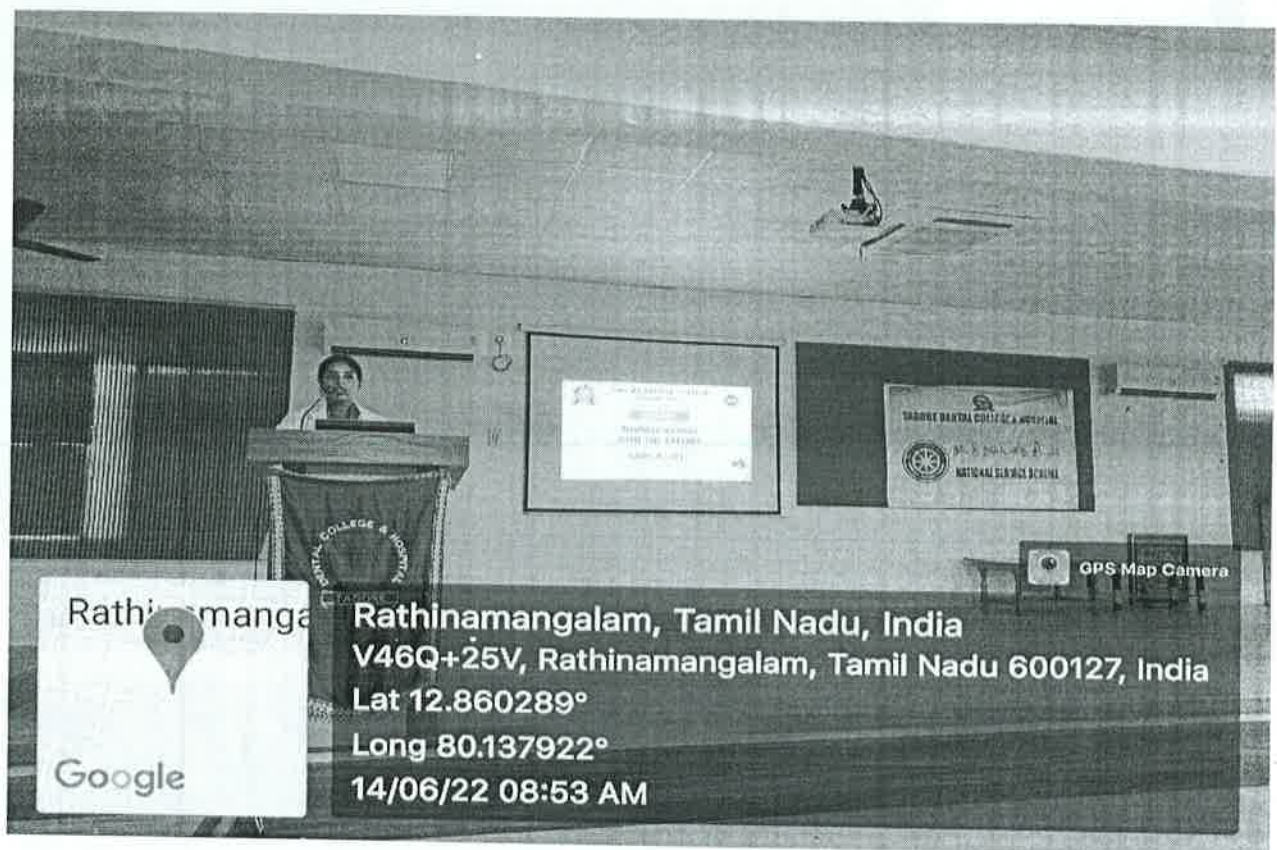
The certificate and memento to guest speaker was presented by Dr. Sai Krishna, Vice Principal (Administration)

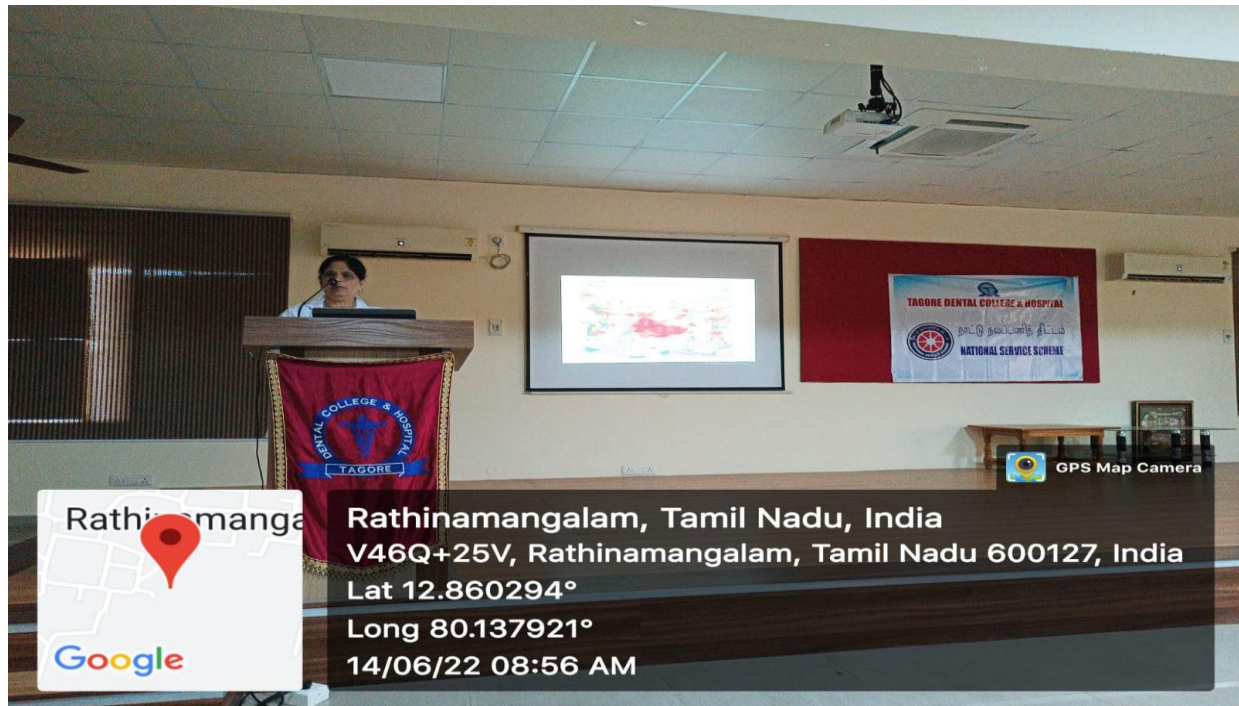
