


# ASSESSMENT OF LEARNING AND COURSE OUTCOMES

### KNOWLEDGE:


The knowledge of the students is periodically assessed using class tests, terminal examination, Google forms for online classes and viva-voce. The outcome of the tests in terms of pass percentage and average score of the class is used to assess the improvement of the students.

**OSCE: Objectively structured clinical examination** 

**OSPE: Objectively structured practical examination**

# Attitude assessment:

Assessment of the student towards a particular concept or value is a continuous process and is assessed during the lecture classes and the practical classes including the out-patient department. The ability of the student to characterize the specific concept, organizing it, valuing the concept, change in the behaviour related to the new concept that was learnt and learning from the experiences.
