


GUEST LECTURE TOPIC: HORIZONTAL JAW RELATION






Concents

 Atwood states that there are two basic concepts of CR.
A. Anatomic concept the most posterior border position is established by ligaments,
b. Physiologic concept the most posterior unrestrained jaw relationship (not a border position) established by muscle action.
