

6th LIVE SURGICAL WORKSHOP & STUDENT CONVENTION

Organizer: Department of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery, Tagore Dental College & Hospital.

Date: 14th & 15th November 2018

Learning Outcome: To acquire knowledge on performing oral surgical procedures in private practice.

Venue: 3rd Floor Auditorium, Tagore Dental College and Hospital, Chennai.

Short Report:

The title of the procedure was “Surgical removal of Impacted Teeth”, by Dr.H.Srinivasan. A live surgical demonstration of surgical removal of impacted mandibular molar tooth was demonstrated by Dr.H.Srinivasan and the surgical session was moderated by Dr.Nabeel Nazar and Dr.Yashoda Ashok.

Following the first live surgical procedure, the inauguration of the program was conducted between 10.30am to 11.00am. The inauguration program began with “Tamizh Thaa Vaazhthu”. Welcome Address given by Dr.B.Anandh, Reader, Department of Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery.

Dr.Chitraa R. Chandran, Principal, Tagore Dental College, Chief Guest Dr.T.Palaniappan, AOMSI – Tamilnadu State Branch President Dr.M.Veerabahu, AOMSI – Tamilnadu State Branch Hon.Gen.Secretary Dr.S.Ramkumar lighted the kuthuvilakku.

Dr.Chitraa R. Chandran, Principal, Tagore Dental College gave a short introduction about the program and highlighted the benefits of Live Surgical Workshop and Student convention program. AOMSI – Tamilnadu State Branch President Dr.M.Veerabahu, addressed the gathering and giving a few insights into the need of the program.

Chief guest of the day was Dr.T. Palaniappan, CEO & Medical Director of Medway Hospital, Chennai. The chief guest addressed the gathering and explained the need for such live surgical programs.

AOMSI – Tamilnadu State Branch, Hon.Gen.Secretary Dr.S.Ramkumar, briefed the gathering about the importance of this program.

Dr.Chitraa R. Chandran, felicitated the Chief guest with a memento and a plant sapling as a continuation of “Go green initiative” by the Association of Oral & Maxillofacial Surgeons of India last year.

AOMSI – Tamilnadu State Branch President, Dr.M.Veerabahu, AOMSI – Tamilnadu State Branch Hon.Gen.Secretary, Dr.S.Ramkumar were felicitated by Dr.Chitraa R. Chandran. Chief guest Dr.T. Palaniappan, CEO & Medical Director of Medway Hospital, Chennai felicitated the invited faculty of the live surgical workshop.

The coordinators of “Awareness run for OMFS” were felicitated by AOMSI – Tamilnadu State Branch President, Dr.M.Veerabahu, AOMSI – Tamilnadu State Branch Hon. Gen.Secretary, Dr.S.Ramkumar.

Vote of thanks was given by the Organizing Chairman Dr.S.Jimson, Vice-Principal (Research), Professor and HOD, Department of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery, Tagore Dental College.

The inaugural function concluded with National Anthem.

Following the inaugural function, the Tagore Oration on “Random talk in Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery” was given by Dr.P.Subramaniam from 11.00am to 11.30am. The Tagore Oration was chaired by Dr.Manikandhan and Dr.Sathyabama. Dr.P.Subramaniam was felicitated by Dr. Manikandhan and Dr. Sathyabama.

Following the Tagore Oration session there was a short tea break of 15mins.

The second surgical procedure was “Oral Biopsies”, by Dr.S.Mahendra Perumal. A live surgical demonstration of incisional biopsy surgical procedure in the right buccal mucosal region was demonstrated by Dr.S.Mahendra Perumal, the surgical session was moderated by Dr.P.Sneha and Dr.Vinesh Ezhil Rajan.

Following the second surgical session there was a lunch break of 30 mins.

The third and final surgical procedure of the first day of program was “Management of Dentoalveolar / Mandibular fracture”, by Dr.M.S.SenthilKumar. A live surgical demonstration of eyelet wiring, arch bar fixation, intermaxillary fixation and right

angle of mandible fracture reduction with miniplates immobilization was demonstrated by Dr.M.S.Senthil Kumar and the surgical session was moderated by Dr.S.Thiruneelakandan and Dr.Emmanuel Azariah.

The first surgical procedure of the second day and the final surgical procedure of live surgical workshop program on 15.11.18 commenced at 9.00am. The title of the procedure was “Implant Surgery”, by Dr.R.Saravanan. A live surgical demonstration of single implant placement in the first molar tooth region of right mandible was demonstrated by Dr.R.Saravanan and the surgical session was moderated by Dr.P.Suresh Kumar and Dr.B.Gajapathi.

Following the surgical session there was a short tea break of 15mins.

The oral presentations of the undergraduate students from various colleges in Tamilnadu began at 10.30am. There were 2 halls assigned for the purpose of presentations as Hall A – Auditorium in 3rd Floor, Tagore Dental College and Hall B – Seminar Hall, Department of Prosthodontics,3rd Floor, Tagore Dental College. A total of 54 presentations by students from various Dental colleges in Tamilnadu was done in the second day of student convention. There were 40 oral and 14 were e-poster presentations. 6 paper and 4 e-poster presentations were done by post-graduate students. 34 paper and 10 e-poster presentations were done by undergraduate students. A total of 8 sessions were allotted in the 2 halls for smooth functioning of oral and e-poster presentations of undergraduate and post-graduate students during the student convention. Each session was moderated by 2 chairpersons

The live surgical workshop and student convention program had a total registration of 180 students from various dental colleges in Tamilnadu. The live surgical workshop and student convention was given 11 CDE points by the Tamilnadu State Dental Council of India with an approval number of 212/18. The program received a good feedback from the participants.
