“7th Live Surgical Workshop & Student Convention – 26.11.19 & 27.11.19”

Organizer: Department of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery, Tagore Dental College & Hospital.

Date: 26th & 27th November 2019

Learning Outcome: To acquire knowledge on performing oral surgical procedures in private practice.

Venue: 3rd Floor Auditorium, Tagore Dental College and Hospital, Chennai.

Short Report:

The program started at 8.30am with registration of the participants and delegates.

The first surgical procedure commenced on the first day of program on 26.11.19 at 9.00am. The title of the procedure was “Surgical removal of Impacted Teeth”, by Dr.D.Prabhu Sankar. A live surgical demonstration of surgical removal of impacted mandibular molar tooth was demonstrated by Dr.D.Prabhu Sankar and the surgical session was moderated by Dr.Deepak A. Pandyan and Dr.D.P.Uma Magesh.

Following the first live surgical procedure, a unique session “Next Gen” Session – Introduction to International AOMS & Craniofacial Surgery was done to inspire the younger generation of students in the fraternity of Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery. Dr.Dipesh Rao, Craniofacial Fellow (Oxford University), John Radcliffe Hospital, Oxford UK addressed the students through the Online webcast and spoke about the ways in achieving an International identity. Following him,

Dr.Praveen Ganesh N., Asst.Professor, Department of Plastic & Reconstructive Surgery, Saveetha Medical College & Hospital, Chennai spoke to the students about the hurdles in Craniomaxillofacial Surgery and how to encounter them.

After the “Next Gen” Session, the inauguration of the program was conducted between 11.15am to 11.45am. The inauguration program began with “Tamizh Thaa Vaazhthu”.

Welcome Address given by Dr.B.Anandh, Reader, Department of Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery.

Dr.Chitraa R. Chandran, Principal, Tagore Dental College, Chief Guest Dr.M.Veerabahu, AOMSI – President, Dr.R.Manikandhan, AOMSI - Tamilnadu State Chapter President, Professor & Head of Department, AOMSI – Tamilnadu State Chapter Hon.State Secretary Dr.S.Jimson, Dr.Praveen Ganesh N., Asst.Professor, Department of Plastic & Reconstructive Surgery, Saveetha Medical College & Hospital, Chennai lighted the kuthuvilakku.

Dr.Chitraa R. Chandran, Principal, Tagore Dental College gave a short introduction about the program and highlighted the benefits of Live Surgical Workshop and Student convention program. Chief guest of the day was Dr.R.Manikandhan, AOMSI – Tamilnadu State Chapter President. He addressed the gathering and giving a few insights into the need of the program.

Dr.M.Veerabahu, AOMSI – President, addressed the gathering and explained the need for such live surgical programs.

Dr.Chitraa R. Chandran, felicitated the Chief guest with a memento and a plant sapling as a continuation of “Go green initiative” by the Association of Oral & Maxillofacial Surgeons of India.

Chief guest AOMSI – President, Dr.M.Veerabahu, Dr.R.Manikandhan, AOMSI – Tamilnadu State Chapter President were felicitated by Dr.Chitraa R. Chandran. Dr.T. Chief guest AOMSI – President, Dr.M.Veerabahu and Dr.R.Manikandhan, AOMSI – Tamilnadu State Chapter President felicitated the invited faculties of the live surgical workshop.

Vote of thanks was given by the Organizing Chairman Dr.S.Jimson, Vice-Principal (Research), Professor and HOD, Department of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery, Tagore Dental College.

The inaugural function concluded with National Anthem.

Following the inaugural function there was a short tea break of 15mins.

After the tea break the second surgical procedure started at 12.00PM. The second procedure was “Oral Biopsy”, by Dr.Kathiravan S.. A live surgical demonstration of incisional biopsy surgical procedure in the right buccal mucosal region was demonstrated by Dr.Kathiravan S., the surgical session was moderated by Dr.S.Leena Sankari and Dr.James Bhagat.

Following the second surgical session there was a lunch break of 30 mins.

The third and final surgical procedure of the first day of program was “Implant Surgery”, by Dr.C.Saravanan. A live surgical demonstration of implant placement

procedure in 36 region of mandible was demonstrated by Dr.C.Saravanan and the surgical session was moderated by Dr.S.Jayakrishna Kumar and Dr.S.Yaseer Arafat.

The first surgical procedure of the second day and the final surgical procedure of live surgical workshop program on 27.11.19 commenced at 9.00am. The title of the procedure was “Orthognathic Surgery”, by Dr.V.B.Krishna Kumar Raja. A live surgical demonstration of mock surgical procedure in the models following Lefort-I with AMO and subapical osteotomy was performed by Dr.V.B.Krishna Kumar Raja and the surgical session was moderated by Dr.S.Jimson, Dr.M.Baskaran and Dr.Thanvir Mohammed Niazi.

During the surgical session there was a short tea break of 15mins.

Following the second surgical session there was a lunch break of 30 mins.

The oral presentations of the undergraduate students from various colleges in Tamilnadu began at 10.30am. There were 3 halls assigned for the purpose of paper presentations as follows Hall 1 – Seminar Hall, Department of Prosthodontics, 3rd Floor, Hall 2 – Seminar Hall, Department of Orthodontics, Second Floor, Hall 3 – Auditorium in 3rd Floor, Tagore Dental College. There were 1 hall assigned for the purpose of poster presentation as follows Hall 1 – Examination Hall, 2nd Floor. A total of 67 presentations by students from various Dental colleges in Tamilnadu was done in the second day of student convention. There were 36 oral and 31 were e-poster presentations. 5 paper and 5 e-poster presentations were done by post-graduate students. 31 paper and 26 e-poster presentations were done by undergraduate students. A total of 8 sessions were allotted in the 4 halls for smooth functioning of oral and e-poster presentations of

undergraduate and post-graduate students during the student convention. Each session was moderated by 2 chairpersons.

The live surgical workshop and student convention program had a total registration of 289 students & delegates from various dental colleges in Tamilnadu. The live surgical workshop and student convention was given 12 CDE points by the Tamilnadu State Dental Council of India with an approval number of 412/19. The program received a good feedback from the participants.
