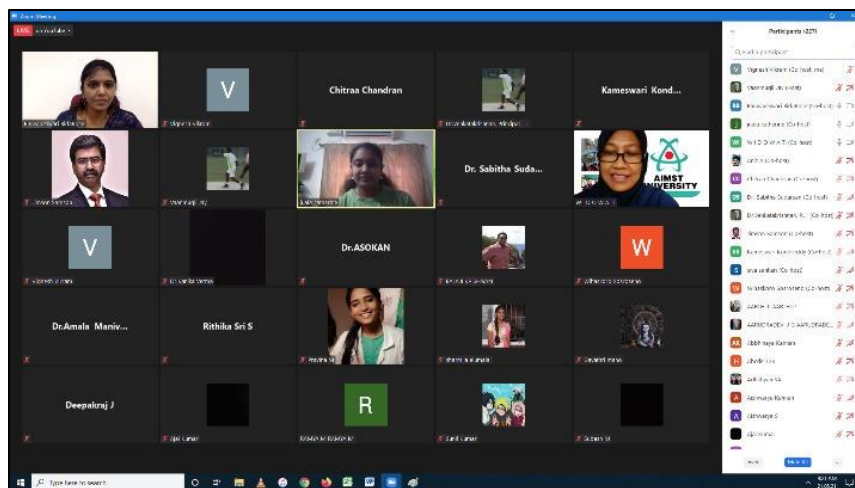

His lecture was very engrossing and he ensured all students picked up the basics of these concepts well through various interesting illustrations and analogies.

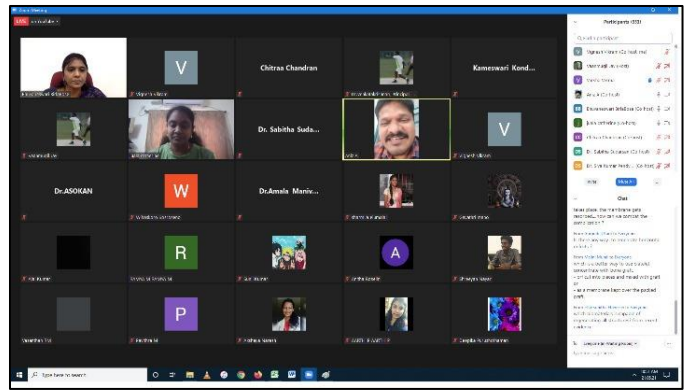
