### INTERNATIONAL WOMEN'S DAY CELEBRATION

The Intern girls of Tagore Dental College and Hospital celebrated International Women's day by conducting a skit on female hygiene awareness among the women at Nedungundram village, Kanchipuram district, Tamilnadu. Around 6 intern girls, 30 first year students who are enrolled in NSS (National Service Scheme), 2 staff coordinators travelled to Nedungundram village to execute the campaign

The main objective of the program was to create awareness against breast cancer, cervical cancer, pregnancy and menstruation and against various social stigmas on menstruation and also emphasize on the sanitary hygiene measures conducive to health.

The awareness programme was conducted by department of Public Health Dentistry in collaboration with National Service Scheme of Tagore Dental College and Hospital. Awareness talk was given by Dr.Premalatha Chief Gynaecologist., Tagore Medical College and Hospital, Rathinamangalam.

She spoke about the women's personal health hygiene and created awareness about the breast cancer, cervical cancer, their diagnosis, examination and methods of treatment.

The program was followed by the distribution of Comfort Layer sanitary napkins for around 120 women in Nedungundram village.

After that, an awareness skit was performed by Intern girls and first year students regarding breast cancer, cervical cancer, pregnancy, menstruation and acid attack awareness.

The campaign involves an awareness speech and skit in Nedungundram village. All the students had actively involved in creating awareness about women health and hygiene among general public on breast cancer prevention and treatment modalities. The response from the public was very good .It was a great eye opener for the general public as they posed all their queries about female hygiene and breast cancer prevention and got them answered. These small acts on International women's Day would have made a phenomenally powerful impact this year.
