### 19.11.2019 – Diabetes Screening Camp and Oral Health Status Awareness

The Department of Periodontics, Tagore Dental College organized a Diabetes screening camp for the elderly residents of **Shirdi Sai Karunai Illam, Anagaputhur, Chennai**. The event was focused on creating diabetes awareness and oral health awareness among the elderly and educating them on proper oral hygiene maintenance.

The interns assessed the Blood Glucose Level, Blood Pressure, Weight and Oral health status of all residents there. They explained the significance of blood glucose levels maintenance and the influence of blood glucose on oral health.

All the residents were actively asked to interact and discuss about oral hygiene practices to be followed by them and the requirements of better oral hygiene maintenance.
