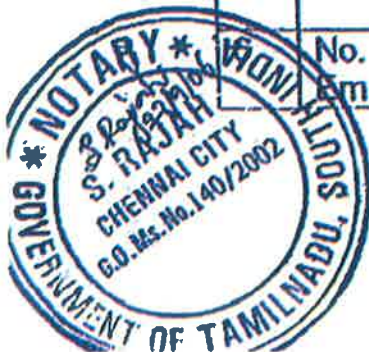

2. The Director of Medical Education was directed to cause an inspection at the premises of the Tagore Dental College & Hospital, Rathinamangalam, Melakkottaiyur, Chennai with reference to the Dental Council of India norms and send the inspection report along with his specific recommendations.

3. The Director of Medical Education has nominated inspection teams for conducting inspections and sent his report and recommendation about the desirability and feasibility for starting of Post Graduate Dental Courses.

4. The Government after verifying the desirability and feasibility, convey permission / Essentiality Certificate for starting of following 4 Post Graduate Dental Courses from the academic year 2018-2019 with an annual intake noted against each of the courses, subject to the condition that norms of the Dental Council of India should be fulfilled and the deficiencies pointed out in the inspections team's report should be rectified before the inspections of the Dental Council of India and also the approval of Dental Council of India / Government of India should be obtained before the students are admitted to the proposed newly starting of Post Graduate Dental Courses:-
